Background

This three-day course of the ADFIAP Career Credentialing Program (ACCP) is intended for top management and Board members of development finance institutions and other same-purposed financial institutions. Participants who have completed Levels 1 & 2 of ACCP can also attend the course.

Participants should propose a topic and submit an abstract before developing the final paper. Selected papers will be published by DFIAP for the benefit of practitioners of development finance.
4. The 2-day program will be conducted in English.
