We are accepting applications from students (on a rolling admission basis) who have business (MBA), economics, finance, development management, international relations, communications,

or any related academic background, to pursue an action consultancy project with us and make an impact through any of the following areas:

- Investment Management and Project Finance
- Development Management Consulting (Focus on Business Development)
- Membership Engagement and Services (CRM and Membership Data Analytics)
- Research and Development to strengthen our Training (course offerings)
- Social Media and Digital Transformation
- Partnerships and Networks

Each student intern will pursue a doable and implementable project in any of the above areas under the tutelage of an assigned officer in ADFIAP. The internship period will be flexible dependent on the requirement of your university vis-à-vis the nature of the project.

Internship candidates must:

- be enrolled in a Master's Program; open to undergraduate students who demonstrate intellectual maturity, resourcefulness, and the potential to independently carry out a project.
- be engaged in academic study in a field directly related to ADFIAP's work;
- possess an excellent command of English.
